# Immersive Learning



When students have an opportunity to learn outdoors they start to 'live their learning'. This experiential method of teaching has been part of traditional Aboriginal culture for millennia. Passing on skills and ancestral knowledge from one generation to the next through practising lore and maintaining customs has preserved the Aboriginal culture, making it the oldest living culture in the world today.

Aboriginal cultural tours and activities provide this same immersive learning experience, giving students the opportunity to explore authentic, project based learning in an outdoor classroom context. With hands on examples that include hunting and gathering, making tools and implements using only natural resources and fostering a deeper understanding of the unique cultural identity of the first Australians.

Many of the tours offer authentic 'on country' experiences, interacting with cultural custodians and elders, who share their knowledge of the land and offer an insight into Aboriginal culture through Dreaming stories, song, dance and a range of activities that encourage group participation and cooperation.

Cultural tours, camps and activities inspire and engage children, fostering cultural awareness and experiential learning.







Whether it's ancient Dreaming stories told around a campfire, cooking freshly caught crab or witchetty grubs over the open coals, tracking wildlife across the desert sands or making a traditional spear or tapping sticks, children feel better, behave better and learn more when we combine learning with outdoor nature-based and cultural activities.

- Research indicates that direct exposure to nature is essential for physical and emotional health as well as normal child development.
- On Country, cross cultural encounters break down barriers and stereotypes, allowing children to gain a better understanding of Australia's first people through cultural exchange and positive learning experiences.
- Shared knowledge – As the world's oldest living culture, the Aboriginal culture has survived by the passing of knowledge from one generation to the next. On Country classrooms give children the opportunity to experience some of this vast collective knowledge of country and culture.




